Official approval and recognition of diplomas

If you wish to study in Spain for over six months, in addition to any visas required, you must also apply for a temporary residence permit, which you can do at your nearest Foreigners' Office, Police Headquarters or Police Station.

If you wish to continue your general education in Spain, the level of education you reached in a foreign country must be validated in a declaration that states the equivalence in the Spanish education system.
